Care 4 Calais

-Most refugees in Calais have come from Afghanistan, Sudan, Eritrea, Iraq, Iran and Syria. -According to the Global Peace index, (ranked 1-4) the most dangerous countries in the world are Afghanistan, Syria, Iraq, and South Sudan

-currently approximately 700 refugees living in and around Calais.

-possessions like sleeping bags are often confiscated by the police. -since 2016 (Jungle Camp dismantled) authorities have been actively discouraging settling here -For the last 3 years, Turkey has hosted the most refugees – at 2.9 million in 2022.

-most of the world's refugees are hosted by the poorest countries -Turkey, Pakistan, and Lebanon top the

list for hosting refugees

-C4C provides basic necessities like clothing, shoes, sleeping bags for those sleep rough -also attempt to help with immigration paperwork and access to health care -attempt to provide interpreters and legal support

-in spring 2017, the Dunkirk camp burnt to the ground. Since then, people have been living in forests and fields -C4C visits twice weekly to deliver food and other supplies to primarily Afghans and Kurds in this area -there are over 1500 refugees sleeping rough in Paris – unlike those in Calais who

rough in Paris – unlike those in Calais who wish to get to the UK, those in Paris wish to stay in France
